The Leadership for Social Good Study Abroad Program in Central and Eastern Europe offers interested students the opportunity to gain insight into global civil society, to learn about the challenges of creating and leading effective and sustainable social enterprises, and to make a positive impact by working closely with a non-profit organization in Budapest, Hungary.

The program takes students to Prague, Czech Republic, Vienna (new location), Austria, and Budapest, Hungary. This program introduces students to the concept of “sustainable communities” and is affiliated with Serve-Learn-Sustain.

## Itinerary (Tentative)

**May 4 – 12, Atlanta:** classes on the foundations of the social sectors and civil society in US and Central Europe

**May 13 – 18, Prague:** in-house lectures and exploring this beautiful city and its culture

**May 18 – 23, Vienna:** site visits to non-profits, museum visits, tour of the castle

**May 23 – July 3, Budapest:** internship, classes, weekend trip, and in-depth exploration at this incredible cultural capital

We highly recommend discussing with your academic advisor. These credits can be used toward a Business Major (as MGT electives or Leading and Managing Human Capital Concentration electives), a Leadership Minor, an Entrepreneurship Certificate, or as free electives for all majors.

## Dates

**November 1, 2019** Early Application deadline

**February 21, 2020** Program fee installment of \$2,500 due

**April 3, 2020** Final installment of \$2,750 due

## Fees

**\$5,900** (Includes: the \$500 deposit required with application; housing in Prague, Vienna, Budapest; some meals (weekday lunches in Budapest, breakfast in Prague and Vienna, and several group dinners); entry fees and costs of all organized group activities; public transport passes, and train tickets to Vienna and Budapest; insurance. Does NOT include GT tuition costs, airfare, meals not covered (budget about \$500), and housing in Atlanta.)
